

## 4-H Contestsand scholarship opportunities

Greene County and Virginia 4-H has a variety of contests and competitions throughout the year in a wide range of subject areas. Youth may compete in a variety of county, district and sometimes even state and national competitions, should they qualify. In addition, many of our competitors receive scholarships to 4-H Camp or 4-H Congress for their participation.

On March 9, Greene County Food Challenge teams will be competing in the Northern District 4-H Food Challenge Contest, and on March 2 Greene HorseShoes members will have the option of competing in the Northern District Horse Bowl. There are also a variety of other shows and contests related to animal science and other project areas that are offered throughout the year to the members of these clubs. Youth enrolled in 4-H School programs are also eligible to enter our contests.

On Thursday, March 14, Greene 4-H will hold County Contests for youth wishing to qualify for the 4-H Northern District Contests in Stanardsville, VA on March 30. Youth may participate in competitions in Chicken/Turkey Barbecue, Egg Cookery, Extemporaneous Speech, Share-the-Fun, Fashion Revue, Presentations, Public Speaking, Radio Spot/4-H Promotion, Science Fair Presentation & Display, Photography and Table Setting.

Youth who are at least 9, but no older than 13 by September 30, 2019 can compete up through District Level and can earn scholarships to the Greene/Fluvanna 4-H Summer Camp, June 10-14.

Youth who will be 14 by September 30, 2019, but are no older than 19 may chose to compete in a number of state competitions at 4-H Congress. Greene County 4-H requires that all youth wishing to attend 4-H Congress meet the following criterion:

- 1. Youth must be an enrolled member of a Greene County 4-H Club as of January 31, 2019.
- Youth must have attended or completed at least six hours of educational programming by attending meetings or completing project work.
- 3. Youth must compete in a county event, then district level event.
- 4. Youth must have completed all required forms by the required deadlines. Go to <a href="https://tinyurl.com/2019-Teen-App">https://tinyurl.com/2019-Teen-App</a> to apply online.



Depending on availability of funds, scholarships to 4-H Camp and Congress are offered to youth for their performance at these events. In addition, several of our 4-H Clubs offer scholarships to youth to encourage them to compete in various events. Youth qualifying in county level

events will receive invitations to District Competitions.



The \$225 covers all meals, a camp t-shirt, lodging, classes, activities and transportation-everything except spending money for the camp store items. Registrations will be accepted until all available slots for campers are full. Financial aid forms will be available by February 15, 2019 and



are due by March 15, 2019. All fees due April 1, 2019. Campers must be 9 by September 30, 2019, but no older than 14 by January 1, 2019.

Campers who wish to be C.I.T. (Counselor in Training) applicants must be at least 13, but no older than 14 by January 1, 2019. Teen Leaders must be at least 14, no older than 19 by January 1. 2019 and must submit a separate application form.

4-H members can earn Camp Scholarships through participation in county and district public speaking, presentation and Share-the -Fun events held in January-April, but PLEASE CONTACT US EARLY FOR MORE DETAILS. All contests require preparation, practice and early registration. Financial aid for camp fees is also available, thanks to the generous donations of local businesses, organizations and individuals.
