The \$225 covers all meals, a camp t-shirt, lodging, classes, activities and transportation-everything except spending money for the camp store items. Registrations will be accepted until all available slots for campers are full. Financial aid forms will be available by February 15, 2019 and



are due by March 15, 2019. All fees due April 1, 2019. Campers must be 9 by September 30, 2019, but no older than 14 by January 1, 2019.

Campers who wish to be C.I.T. (Counselor in Training) applicants must be at least 13, but no older than 14 by January 1, 2019. Teen Leaders must be at least 14, no older than 19 by January 1, 2019 and must submit a separate application form.

4-H members can earn Camp Scholarships through participation in county and district public speaking, presentation and Share-the-Fun events held in January-April, but PLEASE CONTACT US EARLY FOR MORE DETAILS. All contests require preparation, practice and early registration. Financial aid for camp fees is also available, thanks to the generous donations of local businesses, organizations and individuals.
